Worship Theme What Matters Most

Scripture Reference Phillipians 3:17 – 4:1

Materials: Suitcase with objects from last 3 lessons and a Bible. (a rock, a jar, and a fishing pole or a pair of shoes with laces)

“What is the most important thing in your life?” Listen for responses. “How does that compare with what God thinks is the most important thing for you?”

Let’s look at what’s in my suitcase. God creates us and starts us on a journey called life. He doesn’t let us go empty handed. He gives us tools for our journey so we can survive. Remember this? (Bring out the pair of shoes or fishing pole) Remember this taught us to dig deeper, to try harder. (Bring out the jar.) Remember this taught us to remove the veil from our eyes so we can see what God wants us to see and learn clearly. (Bring out the rock.) Remember this taught us that fasting is a tool we can use to draw closer to God and be strong thru Him.

This last object is the most important of all. What is this? That’s right a Bible. What’s it good for? (Listen for responses) That’s right. It’s also a roadmap to guide us thru life. All of the lessons we need to learn are right here in this book. It tells us how to deal with every situation we will ever come up against.

Did you know it also tells us what matters most to God? Yep, what matters most to God is that we love Him and we share that love with everyone we meet. If we all love each other and love God, what will there be on Earth? That’s right, Peace!
